

# BW Wells Paintings Traveling Exhibit



North Carolina State Parks has created a traveling exhibit on the paintings of B.W. Wells. They are re-creations/re-printings of digital images of the real paintings. Printed directly onto canvas material they look visually authentic.

- Display space: 7 feet wide x 13' long to include ADA space around it
- Includes: panels and 57 images of his 300+ paintings
- Double sided, each painting is labeled and numbered.
- Paintings are of landscapes throughout North Carolina and Rock Cliff Farm, including Zeagle's Rock. Portraits including pine needle pointillist style, local people, local homes and churches.
